Spiritual Disciplines- Confession and prayer

(Jeremiah 29:11)

Let's Read...

James 5:16

Let's Talk...

What is sin?

(Doing the wrong thing. God tells us the right things to do, and when we do things not God's way, that is sin. God tells us to be kind. When we hit someone, that is not kind and not God's way.)

What things can you think of that are sin and are not God's way?

(Hitting, kicking, disobeying/not listening, taking things, using mean words, etc)

What should we do when we sin?

(Pray and talk to God. Tell him what happened, say sorry, and ask Him to forgive you. Jesus always forgives us! We can also tell a parent or adult. They can help you talk about it, pray about it, and fix it.)

Does Jesus expect us to be perfect?

(No! That is why He died on the cross for us. To forgive our sins because he knew no-one is perfect. Only Jesus and God are perfect. Jesus loves you just as you are and wants to help you live God's way.)

Let's Pray...

"Dear Jesus, Thank you for loving me and caring for me. I pray that when I make mistakes I could be honest and learn from them, Amen."

Spiritual Disciplines: Generosity and Tithing

Let's Read...

Psalms 112:5

Let's Talk...

What does giving mean?

(It means showing others you care about them by sharing your time, things, money, and heart with others.)

How does _mom/dad/guardian/grandparent/sibling_ show you they care about you? What are they giving to you when they do that?

(Examples; Mom makes us lunch and dinner every day- that's giving her time. Grandma calls and talks to me on the phone and shares her heart. Dad takes me out to get ice cream- that's giving his money and heart. Brother shares his toys- that's giving his things. Etc.)

When have you shared or given a gift to someone?

(Examples: sharing toys, helping mom with dishes, buying a gift for someone, helping Dad with chores, etc.)

Have you ever given a gift or done something nice for someone and it made you feel good?

(Parents: Share an example of this in your own life and then help your child see if they can think of a time they did that too.)

What is one way you could be generous this week?

Spiritual Disciplines: Sabbath (Genesis 2:2-3)

Let's Read...

Matthew 11:28

Let's Talk...

What is sabbath?

(It is a day to rest and worship God.)

What does it mean to rest?

(No more busyness. Find calm. Slow down and find peace.)

Why is it important to have a day of rest?

(Did you know God took a day of rest? After creating the world and everything in it for 6 days, God rested on the 7th day. Taking time to rest is good for us to.)

What are some ways to rest?

(Sleeping in. Going for a walk. Reading a book.

Doing a puzzle. Reading the bible. Praying. Playing a game with your family. Taking nap. Eating a meal with your family at the table. Going to church. Listening to worship music.)

What sounds nice and relaxing for you to do on Sabbath?

Jesus Rescues Us!

Let's Read...

1 Corinthians 15:57-58

Let's Talk...

Did you know Jesus came to rescue us? What did he rescue us from?
(Jesus came to rescue us from sin.)

What is sin?

(Doing the wrong thing. God tells us the right things to do, and when we do things not God's way, that is sin. God tells us to be kind. When we hit someone, that is not kind and not God's way.)

Why do we need to be rescued from sin?

(Because sin separates us from God and breaks things. God is perfect and holy and can't be around sin. So when we sin, we are separated from God and it breaks our world and our hearts. God sent Jesus to make a way back to Him and to heal what sin broke.)

Let's Pray...

"Dear Jesus, Thank you for dying for us and forgiving us of our sins. Thank you for rescuing us from sin and making a way back to God. We love you, Amen."
