Let's Read...

John 21:25

Let's Talk...

What were the disciples afraid of? (They were afraid of the big storm and they thought the boat might sink.)

What did Jesus do when the disciples went to Him? (He told the storm, "Quiet! Be still!" and the storm stopped.)

What storms (hard or scary things) are you facing in life right now?

When we go through a storm in our lives, what can we do? (We can pray and ask God to help us and give us peace.)

Let's give our "storms" to God and ask Him to fill us with His peace.

Bible Story: Jesus feeds the 5,000 (John 6:1-13)

Let's Read...

John 21:25

Let's Talk...

Where did the disciples get the food to feed all the people? (From a young boy)

What food did they have? (Five loaves of bread and two fish)

What did Jesus do with the food? (He fed the crowd until they were full. There was even leftovers.)

Where have you seen God provide for you and your family?

What are some needs you could trust God with this week?

Let's thank God for providing for us.

Memory Verse: 2 Corinthians 5:17

March 15th

Jesus does impossible things!

Bible Story: Jesus walks on water (Matthew 14:22-33)

Let's Read...

John 21:25

Let's Talk...

How did the disciples react when they saw Jesus? (They were scared because they thought Jesus was a ghost.)

What did Jesus say to help them with their fear? (He told them that it was Him walking toward them and not to be afraid.)

Why did Peter begin to sink? (Peter allowed his fear to be bigger than his faith in Jesus.)

What does it mean to have faith? (Having faith is choosing to believe in God even though you can't see Him, having confidence in who He is.)

How can we develop a strong faith in Jesus? (We can develop a strong faith by reading God's word, praying, and learning from other believers.)

Let's Pray...

Let's ask God to help us build our faith in Him.

Jesus does impossible things!

Bible Story: Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead (John 11:1-44)

Let's Read...

John 21:25

Let's Talk...

Who was Mary and Martha's brother? (Lazarus)

Why was everyone crying when Jesus arrived at the home of Mary and Martha? (Lazarus was dead.)

What did Jesus do when he saw Mary and other people crying? (Jesus cried.)

What happened when Jesus called Lazarus' name in front of the tomb? (Lazarus came alive and came out of the tomb.)

**Why do you think Jesus cried, even though He knew He'd bring Lazarus back to life?
Why do you think Jesus chose to raise Lazarus from the dead, rather than heal him while he was sick?**

When has God given you hope or helped you feel encouraged when you were sad?

Let's Pray...

Let's thank God that He cares about us when we're sad, understands how we feel, and brings hope in those times.

Jesus is King!

Bible Story: Palm Sunday (Matthew 21:1-11)

Let's Read...

John 12:13

Let's Talk...

How did Jesus ride into Jerusalem? (He rode in on a donkey.)

How did the people respond when he came? (They ran to see him and waved palm branches in the air. They shouted Hosanna!)

What do you think Hosanna means? (Hosanna means 'Save me, please!')

Why did the people shout Hosanna? (They shouted Hosanna with joy and praise because they knew the Promised Savior had finally come.)

If Jesus were coming to town today, how do you think people would react? How would you react?

How can you praise Jesus as your king and savior this week?
