Let's Read...

John 14:2-6 and John 3:16

Let's Talk...

Is heaven real or pretend? (Heaven is real. Jesus spoke about it as a real place.)

What excites you most about heaven?

Who is preparing a place in heaven? (Jesus! He is preparing a place for those who belong to Him.)

How do we get to heaven? (By believing in Jesus and surrendering our lives to Him.)

How can knowing about heaven change the way you live today? (We can have hope when we face hard things because Jesus has promised eternal life with Him in the most perfect place ever.)

Thank Jesus for the hope of heaven.

We love Jesus by being generous!

Let's Read...

Ephesians 3:20 and Acts 20:35

Let's Talk...

What does it mean to be generous? (Being generous means gladly sharing what you have and helping others.)

Is it better to always get things or to give to others? (Jesus said it is better to give than to receive.)

What are some things you can give besides money? (You can give your time, help, toys, encouragement, kindness, or a smile.)

What can you remember when a generous act seems small? (Remember that God can use all generosity in big ways. He works through His people by His power.)

How can you and your family be generous this week?

Let's Pray...

Thank Jesus for His generous love and ask Him to help you gladly share what you have with others.

Go build God's Kingdom!

Let's Read...
Matthew 28:19-20

Let's Talk...

What did Jesus tell His followers to do? (Jesus told them to go and make disciples. Disciples are followers of Jesus.)

Who should hear about Jesus? (We should want everyone to hear the good news about Jesus.)

Does Jesus expect you to do this mission alone? (No! He promises to always be with us.)

How can you help build God's Kingdom? (You can share about Jesus with your friends or invite friends or classmates to church.)

Who is one person you can share Jesus with?

Let's Pray...

Ask God to give you boldness and bravery in sharing your faith with others.

1st-5th Grade

September 27th

Campfire: Wild Stories of the Bible
Memory Verse: 2 Timothy 3:16-17

God is always in control!

Let's Read...

Numbers 22:21-39

Let's Talk...

What did the donkey see that Balaam could not see? (The donkey saw an angel of the Lord standing in the road.)

Why did the donkey stop and move away from the road? (The donkey was trying to protect Balaam from the angel's drawn sword.)

What amazing thing did God do? (God made the donkey speak to Balaam.)

Who was really in control of Balaam's journey? (God was in control. He knew what Balaam was doing and stopped him.)

What can you remember when something does not go the way you planned?
(You can remember that God is in control, even when you do not understand why something happened.)

Let's Pray...

Talk to God about something that feels hard or out of your control. Thank Him that He sees what you cannot see. Ask Him to help you trust Him.
