WHY SHOULD I SERVE?

We can't wait to empower you to be the servant leader God created you to be. We don't want you to fill a gap; we want you to fill a purpose. Serving is one of the best ways we know of helping people look more like Jesus.

WHY SERVING MATTERS

Serving isn't just something the church needs — it's something you need to grow spiritually.

Serving helps you:

- Look more like Jesus
- Discover your gifts
- Build confidence
- Make a difference
- Grow in maturity
- Connect with community

Jesus didn't come to be served, but to serve (Mark 10:45). If you want to follow Him, serving is part of the journey.

Knowing where to serve can be intimidating, here are some good questions to ask yourself:

- 2) Are you more available on Wednesday night's or Sunday?
- 3) What are your spiritual gifts (If you don't know these talk with Tristen and he will direct you on how to find those out)
- 4) What brings you the most joy in life?
- 5) What kind of personality do you have? Are you more extroverted or introverted?
- 6) What have you experienced in your life, that could possibly help you serve better in that position

SUNDAY SERVING OPPORTUNITIES

CAFE TEAM

Serve a Warm Cup of Coffee and Hospitality, Maintain High Level of Cleanliness and Food Safety; Once Monthly Serving Commitment; Sunday

ELEMENTS TEAM

Helping with the Set-Up and/or Tear-Down of Worship Elements, Communion Stations and Worship Center Environments Before and After Services; Twice Monthly Commitment; Sunday

FACILITIES TEAM

Help Steward Trace's Property Well, Set Up Events, Help Maintain Cleanliness and Operations; Twice Monthly Serving Commitment; Sunday

PARKING TEAM

Help with Traffic Flow On and Near Trace Property; Twice Monthly Serving Commitment; Sunday

PRODUCTION TEAM

Help Run Lights, Sound and Camera Equipment during Weekly Services; All Training Provided; Twice Monthly Serving Commitment; Sunday

MS STUDENT TEAM

Work Directly with Middle Students for Weekly Services and Special Events; Weekly Commitment; Sunday Night

TRACE KIDS TEAM

Serve with Infants Through 5th Grade or Special Needs; 2-4x Times Monthly Commitment; Sunday

WELCOME TEAM

Greet Guests with Warm Hospitality and Usher into Trace Spaces; Twice Monthly Commitment; Sunday

OUTSIDE OF SUNDAY SERVING OPPORTUNITIES

HOPE FOR HER

Women's Monthly Connection Brunch, Ongoing Groups, and Special Events; Monthly Serving Commitment; Saturday Morning

MISSION READY MEN

Leading a Table; Monthly Serving Commitment; Second and Fourth Monday Mornings

HIGH SCHOOL WEDNESDAY NIGHT SERVING OPPORTUNITIES

SOCIAL MEDIA TEAM

Help take photos and videos for instagram, edit content, help manage and post on our socials. Also helps in the development of content for our page

WELCOME TEAM

Help welcome all students and guests that come through our doors on a wednesday night. Help make every guest feel known, seen and loved

FIRST TIME GUEST TEAM

Help check in new students and assist in getting them connected with other students and their leaders

LOBBY CULTURE TEAM

Help make sure that no students are alone, get everyone involved and help plan activities and games in the lobby

PRODUCTION TEAM

Help with lights, sound, camera and slides during worship and the message

WORSHIP TEAM

Help lead students in worship whether it be vocals, guitar, drums, bass, or keyboard

HOW DO I START SERVING?

Step 1 - Fill out the application for the serving team you are interested in joining on the trace church website: next Steps page or talk with Tristen.

Step 2 - After you have filled out the application be in prayer and be responsible and keep up with communication once the ministry leader reaches out to discuss with you.
